

General Code of Conduct



Last updated: May 2024

You must ensure the standards of the **Fair Play Code** are applied by demonstrating the five core values that will lead to fair play for all:

- Integrity
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Fairness
- Safety

As a person required to comply with this regulation, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Calisthenics Victoria, an Affiliated Club or Competition.

1. Fully comply with the **Child Safety in Calisthenics Code of Conduct**.
2. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
3. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
4. Be professional in and accept responsibility for your actions.
5. Be aware of, and maintain Calisthenics Victoria's standards, rules, regulations and policies.
6. Operate within the rules and regulations of Calisthenics Victoria, affiliated Clubs or Competitions.
7. Do not use your involvement in calisthenics to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of Calisthenics Victoria, affiliated Clubs or Competitions.
8. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are example.
9. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible.
10. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring Calisthenics Victoria, affiliated Clubs or Competitions into disrepute.
11. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity.
12. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
13. Be a positive role model.
14. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or aware of any breaches of the Code of Conduct.
15. Note this Code of conduct also applies to the use of social media as per the Calisthenics Victoria Social Media Moderation policy.
