

# Junior Performer Code of Conduct

You must ensure the standards of the **Fair Play Code** are applied by demonstrating the five core values that will lead to fair play for all:

- Integrity
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Fairness
- Safety

In addition to **Calisthenics Victoria General Code of Conduct**, as a performer in any activity held by or under the auspices of Calisthenics Victoria, Region, an Affiliated Club or Competition you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any such activity or event.

1. Fully comply with the **Child Safety in Calisthenics Code of Conduct**.
2. Participate because you enjoy it, not just to please parents and coaches.
3. Play by the rules.
4. Know the rules.
5. Participate fairly and safely.
6. Abide by decisions, without argument or bad temper.
7. Respect adjudicators
8. Cooperate with your coach, and other performers, deliberately fouling or provoking an opponent and throwing / damaging equipment is not acceptable or permitted.
9. Cooperate with your coach, and other performers.
10. Treat all performers as you would like to be treated.
11. Ensure that at all times your behaviour is fair.
12. Be a patient and enthusiastic supporter of fellow performers.
13. Applaud all good performance, by your own team and opponents.
14. Be a responsible team member.
15. Always be on time.
16. Encourage and assist all performers.
17. Attend all training sessions.
18. Ensure you always bring the appropriate uniform and equipment to class and/or competitions.
19. Do not engage in practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco and drug use).
20. Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play (volunteers, timers, coaches, technicians, administrators).
